17th SPHINX LONG-DISTANCE TRIAL

Incorporating the Geoff Gibbon's Memorial Trophy

1. An event for two wheeled vehicles, held under the NSC's of the ACU and the MSA together with any applicable Standing Regulations, and the following Regulations applicable to the classes eligible for this event. The Geoff Gibbons Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the best competitor riding a trail bike who is resident in the Western Centre. The event is only open to members of the CHGMCC.
2. The entry list closes on **9th April 2010**. The entry fee is **£25:00 for Club members or £28.00** to include 2010 membership - **all entries include a coffee and a bacon roll at the start and a beer and a sandwich at the end of the trial**. All entries must be sent to the Secretary of the Meeting with the correct fees and 2 SAE's. Acceptance of entry will be advised with the final instructions after the closing date. Entry fees are non-returnable after the closing date unless the event is cancelled.
3. The start/finish will be at **Hazleton Village Hall**, off the A40, 9 miles east of Cheltenham, postcode GL54 4DX. The entry will be grouped in order of receipt and is **LIMITED TO 120**.
4. The first rider will be away at **9:01am** with subsequent riders at 2 per minute. Riders will sign on/off at the start/finish. Any rider who does not start at their due time will be penalised one mark for every minute they are late up to a maximum of 20 mins after which they will be deemed a non starter.
5. The route of approx. 65 miles as indicated on the route card must be followed throughout the event. This is a traditional non-stop trial, which will include a graded hill-climb and 2 Special Tests. The onus of finding the sections rests with the rider. **O.S. map 163/151** is used throughout. Inspection of the sections is not allowed unless otherwise stated. Competitors have a maximum of **Six** hours and **thirty** minutes to complete the course. Sections will close with the back marker. In the event of a tie, the Special Test results will be used to decide.
6. Front & rear numbers will be supplied and must be worn and kept clean at all times. **TRIALS TYRES ONLY SHOULD BE FITTED ON THE REAR WHEEL.**
7. As this event is being run on public roads, drivers are requested to make a special effort not to cause any annoyance to other road users, or residents on route with excessive noise or inconsiderate parking. Please give way to walkers and horse-riders.

- 9. INSURANCE:** The club has applied to Loctkon for cover note. This will provide competitors who need to use the scheme with third party cover to meet the minimal Road Traffic Act requirements for the road sections of the event. You must comply with all of the following: Be over 21 years of age; Have had not more than one fault accident in the last 3 years; Have no more than 6 speeding points on a licence; Have no physical or mental disabilities; No other material facts. A premium of **£10.00 for up to 24 hours cover** is payable. If you **do not** require this cover you **MUST** sign the declaration on the entry form.

- 1st Class awards to next 10% of entry. Class 2 is **NOT** eligible for the overall winner's award. Class 8 is eligible for the Mark Kirby Trophy only
