Sportsman route

marked with Red (Right) and Blue (left) with Yellow Marker Deviation.

Solo Adults of Expert , Intermediate and Novice status. Note – Riders over the age of 40 should state “OVER 40” on their entry form. (Example “Novice over 40”)

Youths of A and B class only.
