Sportsman Plus route (50/50) identified by a sign at the start of the section.

Sportsman route marked with Red (Right) and Blue (left) with Yellow Marker Deviation.

Youth C, D, E and raw beginners route

There will be a conducted route of approximately 6 sections for riders in these classes which may include deviations on the Sportsman route.
