Class Options

Adults of Expert , Intermediate and Novice status. Note – Riders over the age of 40 should state “OVER 40” on their entry form. (Example “Novice over 40”)

Youths of A and B class only.

Awards

Standard route ; Best performance – Hurrans trophy, Second place – Ramstedt Trophy

Third place – Harper Trophy, Best G&C member – An award, First class awards to next best 10% on standard route, Awards to :- Best Intermediate, Best Novice, Best Youth A.

Alternative route Awards to :- Best Intermediate, Best Over 40 Intermediate, Best Novice, Best Over 40 Novice, Best Twin shock, Best Youth A, Best Youth B (125cc max)
