EVENT 1 Pre 75 solos 250cc; EVENT 2 Pre 75 solos 350cc; EVENT 3 Pre 75 solos 500cc
EVENT 4 Upright solos unlimited cc; EVENT 5, 500cc Sidecars**

ENTRIES

The entry fee of £30 solos, £35 sidecars includes all compulsory ACU insurance and permit fees, and also allows free admission for two (rider & helper/mechanic)
All entries must be made on the official entry form, C8-2006/1 copy attached, (also available on the ACU western centre web site, acuwesterncentre.org.uk), and sent to the secretary of the meeting John Banner at his address above. All entries must be accompanied by the correct fee, cheques made payable to G.J. (John) Banner, and a stamped self addressed envelope included for riders final instructions/passes etc

Closing date Midnight Saturday 9th August 2008. Late entries will not be accepted
Please send your entry as early as possible. This meeting is expected to be over subscribed

Note: Standing regulations 2.17 Riding in the pits, 4.8 Protection for front engine plates, 4.19 Oil catch tanks, and environmental code 6 use of environmental mats, will be strictly monitored

The track will be approximately 360 metres (400 yards) in length, in a flat grass field, with an elastic off track starting gate

Gate positions will be printed in the programme and will be adhered to
In the event of a tie ACU Championship rules will apply
