## **Route / Course options**

**Expert. (Hard) Route**: marked with pairs of white markers when deviating from clubman route

**Clubman Route** : marked with Red (Right) and Blue (Left) markers

**Sportsman Plus route** riders will ride the clubman route where marked at beginning of the sections comprising of a mixture of sportsman and clubman sections

**Sportsman** route variation marked with pairs of yellow markers when deviating from Clubman Route

**Green Route** an easy route available for beginners, adults and youth (D&E and Oset electric bikes) will be a conducted route. The route variation will be marked with pairs of green markers when deviating from other routes, 2 Laps of 10/12 sections (final instructions on the day will apply)

**Riders Numbers** two must be displayed at all times. (as per Western Centre guidelines)

## **Class Options**

Solo Adults of Expert, Intermediate and Novice status. Note – Riders over the age of 40 should state “OVER 40” on their entry form. ( Example “Novice over 40”) Youths of A;B;C; D;E to ride Green route

**NOTE** Entrants should complete the option box on the entry form as to which type of award they wish to receive!!

**Expert route** ; ; BP;- Les Davis Shield;- 2<sup>nd</sup> BP;- an award, Best Inter;- an award, Best youth;- an award

**Clubman route** :- Best Novice Malcolm Davis Shield;- Best Inter over 40;- an award. Best Inter;- an award. Best Novice over 40 ; - an award;- an Award, Best Twin Shock- an award ; - Best Youth;- an award

**Sportsman Plus route**;-Best Adult an award;- Best twin shock an Award ; - Best youth;- an Award ;

**Sportsman route** :-Best Adult an award;- Best Youth an award;- Best P65/Twin Shock

**Green Route** Awards to winners of Adult; D and E & Oset classes
